Black: Boys Varsity basketball is in 4th place right now

Christensen: Boys Soccer -- both JV and varsity are a little down this year.

Varsity record is 8-6-2. JV is 1-3.

Bezner: Girls Soccer -- JV is 3-3-2, varsity is 2-4-3. Team chemistry is really good this year

Wight: Wrestling is 6-3 in duels since last report. Placed 1st at PESH tourney. Our tournament had to be canceled due to power failure. We ended up second.

Wright and Rodriguez: Our first meet is on 2/22. Commonwealth Relays are 2/28. We are hosting a meet on 03/12. We will also be hosting the Jr High District meet on 04/02/09, and need help with concessions.
