**(Toler):** Volleyball lost a close one at McKinney Boyd 15-9. We play Plano East at home on Friday – everyone encouraged to come early for volleyball before the football game.

**(B.J. Smith):** WEHS football is 3-2-1. Lost very few due to grades. They play Jesuit this week at home.
